Company announces receipt of first J4500 MCI motor coaches in United States to have 3pt seatbelts.

Four J4500 MCI motor coaches delivered to Kobussen Buses, Ltd.-Trailways are ahead of industry standards with 3 point seatbelts, clean diesel technology, stability control, WI-Fi, and 110 outlets.

Kaukauna, Wisconsin- January 12, 2009- Kobussen Buses, Ltd., a Trailways member, and one of Wisconsin's premier charter carriers announces receipt of four luxury 2009 MCI J4500 motor coaches to their current fleet of over 400 vehicles. These coaches are the first of their kind in North America to offer advanced safety equipment such as 3 pt Seatbelts, GPS vehicle tracking, clean diesel technology, backup cameras, and a fire suppression system. These vehicles are designed for the business traveler yet comfortable for school groups by including Wi-Fi and 110 outlets.

“Though there are no current laws that require such equipment, Dan Kobussen said, “We think seatbelts are going to be a standard part of the future coach.”

Kobussen Buses got its start in 1938 when Dan's dairy-farmer grandfather, Elwood “Goldie” Kobussen, began transporting students to and from Kaukauna High School. The company then known as Kaukauna Bus Service, started serving schools in other communities as well, finally changing its name to Kobussen in 1976. In 1983, the company expanded into luxury motor coach charters.

Today, the company, a Trailways member, serves a wide variety of charter clients, continues to serve schools, runs a Para transit service, maintains a scheduled service route and moves troops for the Department of Defense.
